PAVILIONS

Providing cover and shade for patrons of the park will be pavilions, which will be reservable for birthday parties, team cookouts, church gatherings, or family reunions. These pavilions will also have a great view of the stage for live performances and services.



FOOD TRUCKS AND GREEN SPACE

Food trucks are rising in their appeal because of their accessibility and variety. We will be installing electrical hook ups for food trucks, which will be adjacent to green space and an already existing playground. These are helpful for burning off energy kids build up in a long day of classes. This area will also benefit school staff and neighbors looking for a bite to eat and some fresh air.



AMPHITHEATER

Crosspointe Park will also feature an amphitheatre with a stage for live performances and worship services. The surface of the amphitheatre will consist of field turf once used at Hornet Stadium generously donated by the Bryant Athletic Department. This surface will also increase the versatility of use in this area. Shades will affordably enhance the comfort of daytime events.



There are several different markets we believe have access to this location: school parents dropping off their kids, mothers of preschoolers, high school staff over the lunch hour, students after school, area business owners and employees along with neighbors at all hours of the day, especially in the evenings. Our desire for the park is it would provide the neighbors and residents a place to gather and economic opportunities that would attract more interest to this area. We would love nothing more than to create a family-friendly environment for Bryant Public Schools and the greater Bryant community to build relationships with one another.
